## 2022 ANNUAL DUES

By the time you receive this newsletter, you should have received your cou-



pons for your 2022 ANNUAL DUES. They were mailed by BB&T Bank to residents in early December, 2021. If you have not received your payment coupons, please call the Walden Lake Community Association Office @ 813-754-8999. In the mailing there were 2 coupons enclosed, one for the January 1st payment and the 2nd one is for the July 1st payment. Dues are \$325.00 semi-annually for homeowners and \$243.75 for Condo owners. You can also pay the full year assessment of \$650.00 for homeowners or \$487.50 for condo owners. If you have not sent in your first half, please do so now and allow 10 days for mailing and posting to your account.


