NON PAYMENT OF DUES AND VOTING RIGHTS

Any homeowner who is 90 days delinquent on their dues(any amount) will be suspended from voting in the upcoming election at the Annual Meeting. This is according to Florida Statutes Chapter 720.305 Sec 4.

(4) An association may suspend the voting rights of a parcel or member for the nonpayment of any fee, fine, or other monetary obligation due to the association that is more than 90 days delinquent.

The suspension ends upon full payment of all obligations currently due or overdue to the Walden Lake Community Association.

All delinquent homeowners will receive notice via US mail.

A total of (3) seats are up for election. The (3) highest vote getters will be elected for three (3) year terms.





HOME IMPROVEMENTS

If you are planning to perform any type of improvements to the exterior of your home, be it painting, landscaping, FIRE/RESCUE fencing, a new mailbox or a new roof, anything that changes the appearance of your home, you will need to

submit an Architectural Application to your homeowner's ACC Committee for approval before starting your project.

Making any improvements without prior approval from your ACC Committee is in violation of most homeowner associations CC&R's in Walden Lake. If this occurs, you may be required to make adjustments at your cost. Doing your homework prior to starting will make your project go much more smoothly. If you are uncertain who to contact, call the President of your HOA and he or she will be able to give you the contact information.

Remember, anything regarding changes within your property, contact your local Homeowners Association. Anything regarding common areas within Walden Lake, contact Walden Lake Community Association.
