I have to mention an ongoing problem: We have a continued problem with underage individuals operating golf carts and other ATVs in the community. Not only are they trespassing on the vacant golf course property, but they are trespassing on our community residents' property. Additionally, non-residents are using our community properties as well. In response to this issue, we have renewed all our Trespass Authorizations with the Plant City Police Department (PCPD) for our community owned properties. If you see a violation, please reach out to the PCPD and they will respond accordingly.



Another point on this subject is the State of Florida has changed the law on operating golf carts in Florida. The golf cart driving age in Florida is currently 14 years old. In summary the new law (HB 949, https://www.flsenate.gov/Session/Bill/2023/949) states, If you're under 18, you have to be at least 15 with a learner's permit or 16 with a driver's license. If you're 18 and older, you must have valid government-issued identification. The law goes into effect July 1st. Please be aware of this change, drivers could face a noncriminal traffic violation.

It is an honor for me to serve this Community as President and myself as well as all Board members are always open to any suggestions you may have to improve our community. Please be involved.

POOL SAFETY FOR CHILDREN

When most of us are enjoying time at the pool or beach, injuries aren't the first thing on our minds. Yet, drownings are a leading cause of injury death for young children ages 1 to 14, and three children die every day as a result of drowning. In fact, drowning kills more children 1-4 than anything else except birth defects.

- Never leave a child unattended in or near water.
- Assign a 'water watcher' to keep track of children.
- Ensure all pools and spasboth in your backyard and any public pool you might visit-have compliant drain covers.
- Teach children to stay away from drains.
- Install proper barriers, locks and alarms on and around your pool.
- Teach children how to swim.
- Know how to perform CPR on children and adults.

FISHING RULES



Summer and fishing go together like ham and eggs. Unfortunately for those who like to dunk a worm under a shade tree, there is very limited legal fishing in Walden Lake.

Here are the rules:

- **Walden Lake:** The big lake is the only legal place for all residents to fish.
- Fishing is only allowed for Walden Lake residents.
- **Retention Ponds:** Residents who own property on the pond and any permitted guests of the resident may fish on the pond from the resident's property only.
- No person shall trespass on any lot or parcel to fish.
- The water from the lake and or ponds may contain chemicals from water run-off. No one shall consume or ingest or allow another person or animal to consume or ingest anything caught within the water bodies.
