Use the following as a guide prior to starting any exterior changes to your home or yard. You must submit a detailed written request to the board for approval. Most requests are answered within a few days. Requests can be emailed or delivered to a board member.

Review your deed restrictions or contact a board member if you have any questions. If you need a copy of the deed restrictions and covenants, please let us know.

You need approval for the following:

New Roof; Exterior Painting; Additions to the building structure; Installing a pool or patio; Expanding or painting a driveway, walkway, or other exterior concrete surfaces; Moderate to extensive Landscaping alterations; Fencing.

No boats, trailers, commercial vehicles or R/V's unless they can be parked in an enclosed garage. We do however allow you to bring them in for loading, unloading or minor repairs. Maximum time allowed for this is 2 days unless you get approval for additional time from a board member.

This community has a rental clause which prohibits rentals in the first two years of ownership, and restricts short-term rentals.
