



Spring Cleaning Tips from Plant City Solid Waste



Did you know that the City of Plant City's Solid Waste Department will pick up the following items from the curb in front of your single-family home?

- Furniture
- Appliances
- Electronic equipment such as televisions and computers
- Car and pick-up truck tires (4 per year at no extra charge)
- Large tree branches (cut up to length of 5 feet and diameter of 1 foot)

Materials must be on the curb by 7 AM. Do not place material less than 3 feet from trash carts and other objects, under power lines, in the street, on the sidewalk, or more than 10 feet from the road. Each account is eligible for one dump truck load free per 12-month period.

Please call Customer Service at (813) 659-4222 to request special pick-up of these items. Eligible items properly placed on the curb will be picked up within 7 business days of the request being received by Solid Waste.



The City will not pick up the following items :

Construction materials*, batteries, propane tanks, paint, motor oil, pesticides, herbicides, pool chemicals, or other hazardous waste.

**Construction materials include: Steel, glass, brick, concrete, roofing, pipe, gypsum wallboard, and lumber. Call a junk hauling company to pick up most of this material or take it to a disposal facility.*

The City has a free drop-off site for motor and cooking oil at the corner of Victoria Street and Plant Avenue, open from 7:15 AM – 3:30 PM, Monday through Friday. You can also take small quantities of used motor oil to your local auto parts store for free disposal.

We encourage you to do "Spring Cleaning" **before hurricane season begins on June 1**. This includes major pruning or cutting of tree limbs. Large items should not be placed on the curb when a tropical storm approaches Plant City because they may not get picked up before the storm arrives. These objects can be blown away by the wind and cause lots of damage. Tree trimming companies are responsible for removing limbs and trunks they cut.

The City reserves the right to refuse to pick up items at the curb if they are too heavy, bulky, or hazardous or cannot be safely accessed by the City's equipment.
